There is a mix of theory and practical modules, with a blend of online and face-to-face learning tailored to the students needs, with garunteed practical placement in our sister company,, Operation K9 Hydrotherapy and Rehabilitation centres in North and East Yorkshire.

The course is made up of 14 mandatory modules, including Advanced Treadmill Techniques, and is assessed via a range of assessment including portfolio work and practical days

Course provision can be tailored, bespoke to each individual learner based on previous experience, location and learning preferences, however there will be mandatory, in-person practical days at one of our centres.

Application and Enrolement

There are no formal entry requirements for this course, however we will hold an informal interview, and do recommend students obtain work experience in a hydrotherapy centre or similar environment if they are new to the industry.

If students have no animal handling experience, particularly with canines, we will require they obtain this elsewhere prior to enrolment onto the course, or they can book a taster day in one of our centres.
